From the Chad National Director

We hereby witness the faithfulness of God in sustaining the ministry of City for the Nations in Chad in 2024. His powerful hands let our brave church planters on the field make so many great impacts among the 19 selected people groups during the year 2024.

The training that our engagers received has really served as powerful equipment to achieve what is needed from them as church planters. God is using the knowledge and skills they received to achieve the great purpose of their staying among the targeted unreached people groups. Where human knowledge cannot work, God has proved himself able to solve the various problems they encountered on the ground. Through their ministry to needy people, God saved many sick people, many miraculous healings occurred in so many places where they are working.

I want to provide four examples of God using our engagers to bring the gospel of Jesus to these people groups:

1. Among the Gorane people group, a father brought his child to our engagers to be prayed for by them. He had been itching excruciatingly from a snake spirit. Glory be to God, the boy was instantly healed and the father of the boy gave testimony of the healing to many people and also to the marabout* of the town. Upon that miracle of healing, many people began to pay attention to the gospel. God touched their hearts. The boy's father, another young man, one woman, and one girl gave their life to Jesus in that week.
2. In Moyto among the Bilala group our church planters

had struggled to make an impact for several months, with most villagers dismissing and deriding them. After this long season of discouragement, God led them to pray for several sick people in the span of a week or so. Because of their intervention in these sickness cases, people in town who have spiritual problems related to their sicknesses are calling upon them for help, and they have been sharing the gospel freely with all of them.

3. So many of our engagers are helping in teaching in the primary schools of the villages. For these services they render to the populations they are well accepted by the communities and are able to share the gospel and train disciples. We praise God for the conversion of so many Muslim students in different fields of our work. Now, the problem is how to help accommodate some of them who are severely persecuted by their parents.
4. In so many places, our mission found favor in the sight of heads and the leaders of the places. In so many villages and towns we were given the lands officially to start churches in Majere, Rounga, Kebet Ndam, Kouka, Arab Babalia, Kotoko Maslam, Kwang and other communities. We praise God for that acknowledgement from our adopted communities.

Breakthrough Among the Rounga

After over a year living and evangelizing among the Rounga people, Jean and Zelote were disheartened. The Rounga have never received a Bible in their language and have almost no believers among their 70,000 people. Jean and Zelote had been deployed with the first wave of engagers in Chad but had seen little good come from their efforts. At national trainings, when other engagers shared about the victories God was working, they could only share about their difficulties. Though the others ministered to them and encouraged them, they both began questioning the clarity of their call to evangelize the Rounga.

Breakthrough came when a believer like you took action. A member of Huntsville, AL's 10/40 Prayer Meeting for the unreached noticed that the reports from Chad indicated that there had been no salvation among the Rounga. He felt inspired to

begin leading others in dedicated prayer specifically for the Rounga. After weeks of this dedicated intercession, the next monthly report came in: dozens of new believers among the Rounga!

Far from being discouraged, Jean and Zelote now lead and oversee a growing movement of new believers. As of the end of 2024, it numbers over 200 individuals. Men and women are coming to faith every week. This is the kind of miracle that becomes possible when believers like you join with what God is doing around the world to proclaim the gospel of Christ to every tribe and tongue.






SHARE

Unify




We cast a vision for them to reach the unreached within their borders. They respond by providing men and women to serve as engagers.

Equip




We train engagers to lead disciple-making movements. They are taught how to identify those receptive to the gospel, share the gospel with them, and train new believers to do the same.
